GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Students who wish to benefit from study mobility must be enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program at Ostim Technical University and must be **full-time students** for at least one semester during the 2026–2027 Academic Year (60 ECTS per academic year, 30 ECTS per semester – coursework or equivalent non-course obligations; exceptions will be evaluated separately).
2. The minimum GPA requirement is **2.20/4.00** for undergraduate students and **2.50/4.00** for graduate students.
3. Applications must be submitted via the **Turkish National Agency Erasmus Application Portal** using the **applicant's e-government (e-Devlet)** credentials.

4. Within the allocated budget, a total of **17** students will be granted financial support. To enable more students to benefit from the program, grants will be awarded for one semester per student.
5. Quotas:
 - Graduate Programs: **1** student from the Graduate School of Natural and Applied Sciences and **1** student from the Graduate School of Social Sciences (total 2).
 - Undergraduate Programs: **8** students from the Faculty of Engineering, **2** students from the Faculty of Architecture, and **5** students from the Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences (**total 15**).
6. Mobility can only be carried out at partner universities and within departments with existing inter-institutional agreements. Applications from departments without agreements will not be evaluated. [Please CLICK HERE](#) to view our agreements.
7. Being selected does not guarantee acceptance by the host institution. The host institution reserves the right **not to accept the nominated student**.
8. Students who were previously accepted but **did not carry out their mobility cannot** be directly deferred to the following year. Each call applies only to mobilities completed within the specified period. Previous selection does not constitute an acquired right. **Such students must reapply**.
9. All students meeting the eligibility criteria may apply regardless of whether they are citizens of the Republic of Türkiye or another country. There are no restrictions for international students within the scope of the Erasmus+ Program.
10. The mobility period for this call covers **01 September 2026 – 28 February 2027**. Mobility must start no later than **15 October 2026** and must be fully completed by **28 February 2027**.
11. **International Students:** A valid “Residence Permit for the Republic of Türkiye” and the personal information page of the passport must be uploaded to the system. **The residence permit must be valid between 01.09.2026–28.02.2027**. The front and back of the residence permit must be uploaded as a single PDF file; the passport page must be uploaded as a separate PDF file.
12. **If the minimum duration (2 months – 60 days) is not completed, the activity will be considered invalid and any pre-paid grant must be refunded.**
13. Students who are selected but fail to withdraw within the specified period without a valid force majeure reason (e.g., visa rejection) will receive a –10 point deduction in future Erasmus+ applications.

APPLICATION EVALUATION CRITERIA

- The scoring method will be applied in the evaluation process. The total score will be calculated out of “100”, and the evaluation criteria and weighted scores listed below will be used:

Academic Achievement Level (out of a total of 100 points)	%50
Language Proficiency Level (out of a total of 100 points)	%50
For the children of martyrs and veterans	+15 puan
For students with disabilities (subject to documented proof of disability)	+10 puan
For students for whom a protection, care, or accommodation decision has been issued under Law No. 2828 on Social Services and Law No. 5395 on Child Protection	+10 puan
For students who themselves, or whose first-degree relatives, receive disaster victim assistance from AFAD	+10 puan
Previous participation in the same type of project (with or without a grant)	-10 puan
Participation in mobility in the country of citizenship	-10 puan
Failure to participate in the mobility despite being selected, without submitting a formal withdrawal within the specified timeframe (to be applied in the event of a subsequent Erasmus application).	-10 puan
Applying simultaneously for both study and traineeship mobility (the deduction will be applied to the mobility type preferred by the student)	-10 puan
For students selected for mobility: Failure to attend meetings/trainings organized by the higher education institution regarding the mobility without a valid excuse (to be applied in the event of a subsequent Erasmus application.)	-5 puan
Declaring participation in the language exam but failing to attend without a valid excuse (to be applied in the event of a subsequent Erasmus application).	-5 puan

- In the final evaluation list, each student will be ranked according to their score in comparison with applicants from their own department. In the event that candidates from the same department have equal scores, priority will be given to the student with the higher academic achievement score; if the academic achievement scores are also equal, priority will be given to the younger student.

- The application evaluation criteria have been determined in accordance with the 2025 Implementation Handbook for Higher Education Student and Staff Mobility between Programme Countries and Partner Countries.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicants must submit a valid foreign language exam result at the time of application.
2. The minimum required score is **60/100** for both undergraduate and graduate students.
3. Students may take the Erasmus+ Foreign Language Exam organized by the School of Foreign Languages on **10 March 2026**. The exam measures Reading/Use of English, Listening, and Writing skills (proficiency exams are not accepted). Students intending to take this exam must select the relevant option in the Turna Portal during application.
4. Previously obtained Erasmus+ language exam results or recognized exams such as TOEFL (approved by the Council of Higher Education) are also accepted. Results must be uploaded in PDF format.
5. Erasmus+ language exam results organized by our university are valid for 3 years. The most recent exam result will be considered.
6. Students who fail to meet the required score will not be evaluated.

GRANT SUPPORT

1. Students participating in Erasmus+ Study Mobility will receive monthly financial support for the period spent abroad.
2. The grant is paid in two installments: 80% before departure and 20% after return.
3. Students who are selected but cannot be allocated a grant may participate with “**zero grant**” status or withdraw from the program.

1. Students who are entitled to participate in study mobility with a grant will receive funding for a maximum of 150 days for one semester. Students whose mobility period ends earlier than this will receive a grant proportional to their actual mobility duration. The mobility period begins with the start of the academic calendar and ends on the date of the final exam.
2. Except for technical reasons, students who fail to complete the participant survey will be subject to a deduction of 20% of the total final grant.
3. For unsuccessful students, a deduction ranging from 5% to 20%, and not less than 5%, will be applied to the grant based on the extent to which they fulfill their credit load obligations.
4. If documents proving participation in the mobility are not submitted, the mobility will be deemed invalid and no grant will be paid; any grant paid at the beginning will be recovered.
5. Additional Grant Support Criteria Document: Please upload an official document to the application system at the time of application to certify this status. Otherwise, this situation cannot be taken into consideration.
6. Participants with special needs and disadvantaged backgrounds may receive Additional Grant Support in addition to the grant they are entitled to. For student mobility lasting between 2 and 12 months, an additional grant of €250 per month will be provided.
